

To get the best use out of your new inflatable dinghy ladder and to make life easier. Please attach properly and check attachment points for loosening or chafe as climbing into the dinghy puts a lot of load on these points.

- If needed, use the length of blue spectra rope provided to make a leash with a loop in one end for the ladder the hook onto and tie the other end onto a secure point on the dinghy,
- Davit lifting points are good.
- Handles and ring glued to the tubes are often not secure enough and can flex too much.
- It is worth through-bolting an eye onto the transom because once you use this ladder, it will become part of your dinghy life.
- It is important that the leash is the right length with the top of the ladder horizontal when folded if it is too loose the ladder will kick-under and not be as easy to use.

As the ladder is made of all marine grade 316 stainless and plastic it is maintenance free apart from keeping it clean and checking for chafe and tightness of fittings.
